Items should not be stored under decks, especially gas cans and other flammables. Items not in use should be properly stored and not laying around. There are also items that need paint or stain, and safety items like trip hazards, improper electrical outlets, etc. If you have a lot, please check your area and make any necessary corrections. Also, if you make any changes such as paint color, decking, etc. you must submit a project request which needs the approval of the Board and then it goes to the State for approval. There was no mention of weeds so great job on controlling those.
