The State Parks people were here last Tuesday and met with the Board, Joe and Phil. Overall, they were very pleased with the Club. They did a walkabout and found some minor infractions which will need to be addressed, and this was the beginning of yearly inspections. The Board did request help with the bank erosion issue, a security gate, better signage for the public and speed bumps. The Board also inquired about the need for additional liability insurance and Julie (State) indicated that the Club should probably have 1mil/2mil. Bill Westerfield from the State did inform the Board that there is a State statute which says "outdoor recreation public facilities are to be used at your own risk" so the public is responsible for themselves. The Board also requested approval for the following projects: extension of the lawn south of the Clubhouse; constructing a trough along the marina to burn driftwood when the water is lowered and the building of a three sided barn on the east side behind the Russian olive trees which would be used for boat storage. The projects should be submitted to the State by October as it takes about ninety days to get approval. So, all in all, it was a great meeting. A complete update of the meeting will be given at the Membership meeting on Friday.

Have not heard from the State regarding the septic system permit. The public comment period is over so hoping no news is good news.
