The Park County Commissioners have been talking about a "free area" but State Parks Superintendent, Dan Marty, who attended the May meeting, stated the area being considered is undeveloped which would not affect the Club.

As mentioned in the last newsletter there have been some concerns with the high cost of propane. Blakeman Propane came out to the Club on another matter and suggested that gas regulators at each trailer be changed out in the fall. The cost is approximately \$48.00 so be thinking about having that done in September or October.

Members voted at the last meeting to approve an expenditure of up to \$6,000 for commercial grade carpet so if you have any fond memories of that lovely carpet come say goodbye to it soon!
