The Commodore mentioned that corrections to lots/trailers must be made by July as that is the next State inspection. Members can review corrections needed in the book the Commodore has put together which is located in the Clubhouse.

The State Parks is updating their master plan and has held meetings and asked for public input. The Commodore attended some meetings which were not well attended. The purpose of the update is to increase uses for the public such as providing hiking trails, parking and other improvements. The Commodore mentioned the erosion problem, and has submitted requests for help but has had no response from the State.

Gary and Mindy are on the election committee, and there has been no one volunteering for the position of Commodore or Director. If members know of someone who might be interested let Gary or Mindy know.

Thanks to twelve volunteers, the docks and slips were treated in two hours. Steve is working on a plan to build a handrail to the slips. The cost will be approximately \$500.00. Terry and Mike volunteered to donate the cost of the materials to build the ramp.

The Crofts are working on new signs for the Boat Club. Commodore Berett thanked the Bradys for the Cinco de Mayo party and the Entertainment Committee for the Scavenger Hunt. All who participated had a great time.

There are quite a few members who have not paid their dues, and have not returned lot leases or slip leases. Dues and leases need to be returned to the Board by July 1.
