Another reminder, this year the State has indicated that they are not going to be lenient with State tags. Vehicles that are in the Park without a day pass or an annual pass will be ticketed. This includes guests so please let your guests know.

If any slip owners that are not using their slips would be interested in letting others use their slips please let the Board know so that information can be posted. Price negotiations can be worked out between the slip owner and person wanting to use the slip.

There is some good news for members.....the debris behind the dumpsters has been cleaned up! Yay!! Also, new ramps were installed! Yay! Thanks to all (Tony Martoglio, Yogi, Lonnie and Denis) for helping with those projects.
