IMPORTANT NOTICE: The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality has published an advisory that a Harmful Cyanobacterial Bloom has been noted at Buffalo Bill Reservoir. If you encounter a potential HCB, the Wyoming Department of Health and Wyoming Livestock Board recommend the following:

- Avoid contact with water in the vicinity of the bloom, especially in areas where cyanobacteria are dense
 and form scums.
- Do not ingest water from the bloom. Boiling, filtration and/or other treatments will not remove toxins.
- Rinse fish with clean water and eat only the fillet portion.
- Avoid water spray from the bloom.
- Do not allow pets or livestock to drink water near the bloom, eat bloom material, or lick fur after contact.
- If people, pets, or livestock come into contact with a bloom, rinse off with clean water s soon as possible and contact a doctor or veterinarian.
